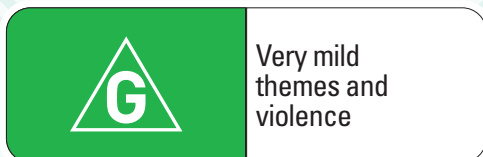

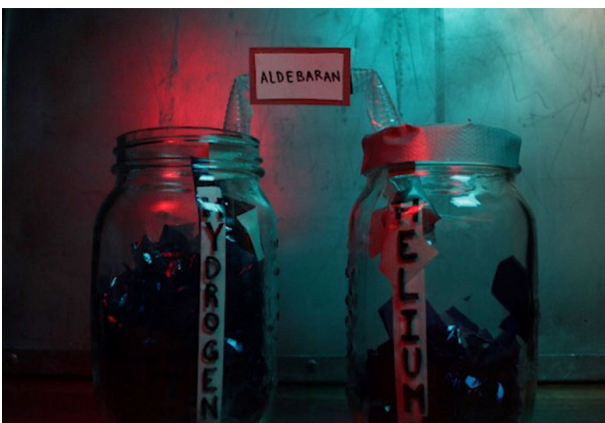
## Running Late (7:37)
