Opening Act Films and Runtime Pictures

**2019 WINNER:** Best Short Fiction (50 minutes or less)

**Keywords:** short film, family, masculinity, morality, childhood, reptile

*Pilè* (Little Bird) is a short drama that captures a moment in a boy's life where his masculinity and morality are in opposition, and the life or death of an unwanted reptile is in his hands.



## Plastic (4:05)

**Keywords:** music video, surreal, love, electronic music, psychology

A stunningly designed and beautifully edited music video, *Plastic* is a real and surreal story of love, loss and construction, counterpointed by the minimalist electronic music of Micra. The work is a collision of emotionally rich psychological drama and cerebral construction, think *Before Sunrise* meets *Inception*.

**2019 WINNER:** Best Middle School (Years 7–10) Animation

**Keywords:** animation, Indigenous, shadow puppetry, live-action

*Frog and Brolga* is the Gija creation story about how Gawarre (Bungle Bungles), Gija people, animals and plants was created. The animation includes shadow puppetry, live-action green screen interwoven with stunning artwork, elements from Country and Gija language. The project involved sixty Gija people ranging from four to eighty years old.

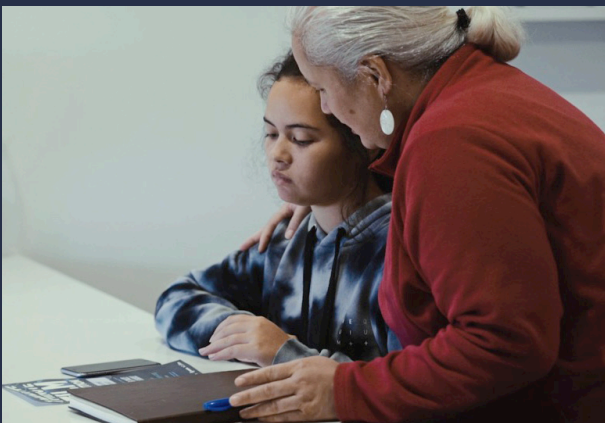
### Technology Revolution (6:00)
